The most important lesson he learned was to see challenges as opportunities for improvement. “To realize those opportunities, we must understand why a challenge exists, determine its ‘root causes’ and work together on solutions.” Health care careers can be tough, but also very rewarding. Having a passion for helping others get the care they need is key to succeeding in health care.
